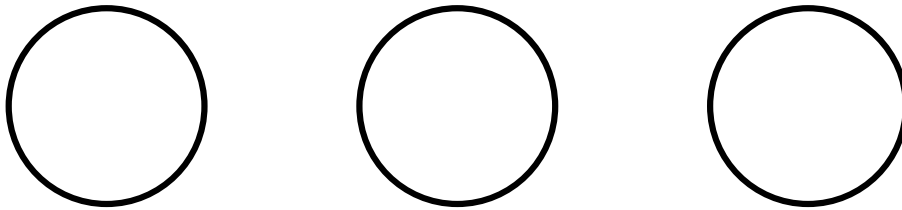

### TIMELINE OF CLUB

#### **STUDENTS ARRIVE:**

WALK IN ACTIVITY: WORD SEARCH

#### **GROUP ACTIVITY:**

THE LINE GAME

**HOW TO PLAY:** A straight line of tape down the middle

One side represents something the other represents something else

You call out the side and students need to be on the correct side

Anyone on the wrong side is out

Examples for each round:

Avengers / DC

Disney / Pixar

Right / Left

Cold / Hot

**SET UP NEEDS:** Tape on the floor

#### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**

1. Was it difficult for you to think quickly about what side to be on? Why?
2. How would you have played the game better next time?
3. How would you try to trick people if you were leading the game?
